Epidemics like COVID-19 are triggered by factors such as changes in the ecology of the host population, genetic changes in an established virus, or a novel pathogen and result in a substantial burden for the world in terms of health risks and unnecessary deaths, economical risks, and global financial turmoil.

The need for effective prevention measures and mitigation strategies is highly urgent. It is essential to capture, understand and monitor the effects of mitigation strategies, as they are perceived and influenced by social media discussions and initiatives.

These measures mostly involve lockdowns at different granularities, durations, and frequencies. Moreover, social media plays a detrimental role during pandemics by monitoring and reflecting the opinion and sentiment of the population.

This workshop will focus on knowledge discovery, mining, and understanding of mitigation strategies and measures during a pandemic to facilitate effective and timely policy- and decision making.
